



## **Description of fishing area „Pielach Classic“ and „Pielach Huchen“**

**Salmonid licence** (Trout and grayling) available from 1 May to 31 December Day card valid in fishing area „Pielach Classic“ and „Pielach Huchen“  
Catch: 3 salmonids, of which only one may be a grayling

**Huchen licence** available from 1 January to 28 February and from 1 September to 31 December.  
Day card valid only in the fishing area „Pielach Huchen“.  
Catch: 1 huchen. In the months of september to december 2 rainbow trout per day card may also be taken.

**PIELACH I/1, I/2**  
**Fishing area 1 (Pielach Classic)**  
**(Schwarzenbach-Mainburg) [S169]:**  
**© CLASSIC**

Includes the Pielach River from the road bridge at the Taschlgraben agricultural road (fishing area sign) and the Natters of the top of the barrage in Laubenbachmühle (marked with fishing area signs) downstream to the barrage in Mainburg (fishing area sign), including the site canals.

All side streams are closed areas.

Allowed fishing gear: fly rod with artificial flies. **In these fishing regulations, artificial flies are defined as dry flies, wet flies and nymphs that have hooks no longer than 20 mm. Jig hooks and tube flies are prohibited. Sighting aids that can go through the top tip are allowed.**

**Fishing is only allowed in knee boots!**

**Fishing season and minimum catch size:**

<b>1. River Trout</b>	<b>16.3.-15.9.</b>	<b>28 cm</b>
<b>2. Rainbow Trout</b>	<b>16.3.-31.12.</b>	<b>26 cm</b>
<b>3. Grayling</b>	<b>1.8.-31.12.</b>	<b>32 cm</b>

Annual licence holders may take 5 salmonids per week; day pass holders may take 3 salmonids per day, of which only 1 may be a grayling. Day pass holders must immediately enter every taken fish in their licence.

River trout of 40 to 50 cm are the most valuable spawning fish and should not be taken.

Each fisherman may only take one trout larger than 50 cm per year. This trout must be entered in the licence.

**Fishing with barbed hooks is prohibited without exceptions (barbless or flattened barbed hook)!**

If they fish both fishing areas in one day, Universal, Große General, Pielach Classic, and Pielach Huchen licensees are requested to enter this separately in their license; in addition, these licensees may fish for a maximum of 14 continuous days in the Pielach once a year. The 14 days can also be divided into two 7 day periods. Before starting holiday fishing, this must be entered on the license. The fishing days must be entered with a "U" before the date. The provisions on fish extraction apply unchanged.

## **Fishing area 2 (Pielach Huchen) (Mainburg-Salau) [S170]:**

From the top of the barrage in Mainburg (fishing area sign) downstream to the municipal boundary between Salau und Uttendorf (400 m downstream of the Salau road bridge), including the side canals and mill streams. All side streams are out of bounds.

Allowed fishing gear: fly rod with artificial flies.

### **Fishing is only allowed in knee boots!**

#### **Fishing season and minimum catch size:**

1.	River Trout	16.3.-15.9.	28 cm
2.	Rainbow Trout	16.3.-31.12.	26 cm
3.	Grayling	1.8.-31.12.	32 cm
4.	Huchen	1.6.-29.2.	75 cm

**Nase, barbel und chub are protected throughout the year.**

Annual licence holders may take 5 salmonids per week; day pass holders may take 3 salmonids per day, of which only 1 may be a grayling. Day pass holders must immediately enter every taken fish in their licence. River trout of 40 to 50 cm are the most valuable spawning fish and should not be taken.

Each fisherman may only take one trout larger than 50 cm per year. This trout must be entered in the licence.

**Fishing with barbed hooks is prohibited without exceptions (barbless or flattened barbed hook)!**

Fishing of huchen is only allowed for holders of annual licences or with a huchen day pass.

1 huchen per licence holder and per year may be fished and this fish must be promptly presented to an official. After removing one huchen, fishing for huchen is prohibited for the rest of the calendar year.

The term „fly fishing“ includes the traditional idea, that the line and not the lure / bait forms the casting weight. False casts and roll casts must be possible with wellbalanced gear. “Slinging” with the help of the weight of the lure / bait with a fly rod is not seen as fly fishing and is prohibited.

If they fish both fishing areas in one day, Universal, Große General, Pielach Classic, and Pielach Huchen licensees are requested to enter this separately in their license; in addition, these licensees may fish for a maximum of 14 continuous days in the Pielach once a year. The 14 days can also be divided into two 7 day periods. Before starting holiday fishing, this must be entered on the license. The fishing days must be entered with a "U" before the date. The provisions on fish extraction apply unchanged.
